Why Should I Choose an Above-Ground Pool?

An above-ground pool allows you to enjoy all the lifestyle benefits of a pool without the steep investment, time, and modifications required to install an in-ground pool:

- **Affordability:** Above-ground pools are much more affordable to install and maintain compared to in-ground pools. The former averages \$8,000 while the latter start around \$70,000.
- **Flexibility:** If you decide you no longer want or need it, an above-ground pool is removable, giving you much more flexibility and autonomy in the long-run.
- **Aesthetics:** With the addition of a deck, an above-ground pool can go from ordinary to oasis, enhancing the entire look, feel, and vibe of your backyard.







I'm Sold! How will an Above-Ground Pool Fit in My Backyard?

It can be overwhelming to think about purchasing and installing a swimming pool, but you don't have to figure it all out alone.

1. Begin by conducting an audit of your backyard:

- First, stake a spot near the center of your backyard. With a tape measure, measure out until you get within 5 feet of the closest fence or structure.
- From that center spot, walk in a circle, maintaining the length of your tape measure. This circle will mark the largest round pool that will fit in your yard.
- Does it fit safely and comfortably? If yes, you are off to a great start. If not, you will need to stake a new spot and repeat the process.
- For oval pools, simply measure the length and width of the largest rectangle that will fit in your yard.

2. Next, review local codes to be sure you're in accordance with safety regulations. As a rule of thumb, any swimming pool must be a certain distance from any structures and property lines:

- 10' from any structures, though some local codes allow 5'
- 5' from any property lines and fences
- · Completely free of overhead electricity lines

3. Finally, review your HOA guidelines and take into consideration your backyard space:

- Is an above-ground pool within all local and HOA codes?
- Where is the closest outlet? This will be needed for your filter system.
- Can digging/leveling equipment easily access your backyard? Crews will need an 8' opening to drive machinery into your backyard to complete installation.





Which Size Pool Should I Purchase?

A home with a pool often becomes a common gathering place for friends and family, especially for children. Think about the number of people you'd like to accommodate in your pool to plan in advance for any parties or gatherings.

What Type of Pool is Best for Me?

Swimming pools not only come in different sizes. They also come in different materials, and the best one for you depends on how it will be used and for how long you want it to last.

Do-It-Yourself Option

Inflatable Top Ring Pool or Soft-Sided Metal Frame Pool

Inflatable top ring and soft-side metal frame pools are the ones you see on sale at Walmart, Sam's, Costco, and similar stores. These types of pools are best for temporary use and are usually suitable for young children or a small family. The typical filter system or vacuum with these pools will not clean this type of pool, making it much more difficult to keep the water safe, clean, and clear. Since this type of pool is an individual purchase through a big box retailer, it also requires self-installation, but it is also a relatively small investment in terms of time, cost, and resources.

Do-It-For-Me Option

Steel Wall Above-Ground Pools

This is a popular choice if you're looking for a semi-permanent, yet flexible, option. With steel walls and vinyl liners, these pools are larger and sturdier than big box, store-bought pools. One of the standout benefits of Steel Wall pools is their longevity, with some models lasting 20 years or more.

Steel Frame

The steel frame pools require carefully maintained water chemistry to prevent corrosion and are unable to withstand saltwater systems. Professional installation is recommended for the best results. Price Ranges between \$4599 and \$7899.

Resin Frame

Resin frame pools are an excellent choice for those looking to avoid the common issues associated with metal frames. Resin is resistant to corrosion and rust, making this type of pool an ideal choice for saltwater systems if you or anyone in your family has sensitive skin. Unlike steel, the top of the pool frame remains cool to the touch, even in the summer sun, providing a safer, more comfortable experience for swimmers. Professional installation is recommended for the best results. Price ranges between \$6,599 to \$16,999.

Hybrid Frame

Hybrid frame pools combine the best of both worlds, featuring a resin top seat with steel posts and connector plates. This design ensures that the top of the pool remains cool to the touch in the summer while providing the strength and durability of steel support structures. Hybrid frame pools are not compatible with saltwater systems, so traditional chlorine maintenance will be required. These pools are priced at a mid-level range, offering a balance between cost and quality. Professional installation is recommended, and expect to invest anywhere from \$5,899 to \$13,999.



How Can I Enhance my Above-Ground Pool?

- **Floating dispensers and chemical feeders** provide convenience for maintaining proper chemical balance in the pool water.

- **Solar covers** help warm the pool water using the sun's energy.
- **Solar panels** reduce energy costs while powering your pool heater or pump.

I'm Ready to Begin. How Can I Ensure Pool Installation is Simple and Seamless?

Proper Installation is essential to enjoying your new investment — instead of stressing over it. Just as bundles of roofing shingles are not of much use without a qualified roofer, an above-ground pool is no good to you without a qualified, knowledgeable installer. You will want to know as much information about your pool installer as possible:

- Is the installer a subcontractor or an employee of a pool company?
- · Have you checked their installation Google reviews?
- · Who handles any scheduling, and are they easy to contact?
- · Who do you call if installation issues arise, the business or the installer?
- Who handles the warranty?

Here's An Expert Installation Checklist:

Before agreeing to an installation, make sure the grounds crew executes the following list:

Leveling

- · Which method does your installer use, sand, dirt, or sod?
- · Level the dirt to within an acceptable range.
- Lay the track on the ground.
- · Install supports under each connector plate.
- · Smooth the floor under the liner.





Underneath the Liner

The installer should not put the liner directly on the ground but should use one of the following methods:

- **Sand**: It becomes hard as concrete with the weight of the pool water.
- **Vermiculite**: It stays soft for the first season then firms up but never as hard as concrete.
- **Pool Pad**: This is similar to a carpet pad, though it will not smooth out bumps and can cause folds and wrinkles in the liner.
- **Nutgrass Killer**: Nutgrass is one of the hardest weeds to get rid of, and this specific form of weed control should be used underneath all pool liners in the Mid-South.
- **Permanent Pool Cove**: This is the transition point where the pool frame meets the ground. The liner rests in this area and the water weight constantly causes stress on the liner in this area. A permanent pool cove provides better support under the liner.
